Local Liquor and Essentials Store – set up and compliance

As part of the nationwide efforts to slow the spread of COVID-19, hospitality venues have been forced to cease serving food and beverages for consumption on-premises.

In a bid to safely help our community, provide a level of convenience and comfort to our locals, and keep our people in a job during these unsettling and ever-changing times, we have re-purposed The Tudor Hotel's Public Bar into a Local Liquor & Essentials Store.

We're offering all your daily essentials such as fresh food, pantry staples, toilet paper and sanitizer, beer, wine, spirits and more.

To ensure maximum hygiene, safety and compliance, we have implemented the following measures in this Local Liquor & Essentials Store:

- Clear signage to communicate social distancing protocols.
- Enforced social distancing achieved through clearly marked 1.5 metre spacings on the floor throughout the shop
- Monitoring numbers through the store to comply with 1 person per 4sqm rule.
- Using floor displays and stacks of product to create clear aisles and separation
- Providing clear direction around the floor stacks to comply with 1.5m rule
- Multiple hand sanitizer stations throughout the store and at point of purchase.
- Encouraging the use of Tap & Go facilities for purchases
- Staff wiping down fridge handles, door handles and any common surfaces every 15 minutes
- Individual bags provided for fresh produce
- All packaged meat and perishables are cryovaced, with use by dates
- Keeping doors open to ensure circulation of fresh air

We have also requested updated safe work practices from our suppliers. Some of the enhanced safety and hygiene and safety measures include, but are not limited to:

- Providing all goods with minimal handling and transfer
- Allocating 1 delivery per truck to avoid cross contamination across deliveries
- Ensuring enhanced sanitisation practices from drivers

As the situation keeps evolving and more restrictions are enforced, we will continue to adjust and update our protocols accordingly, always staying one step ahead where possible.
